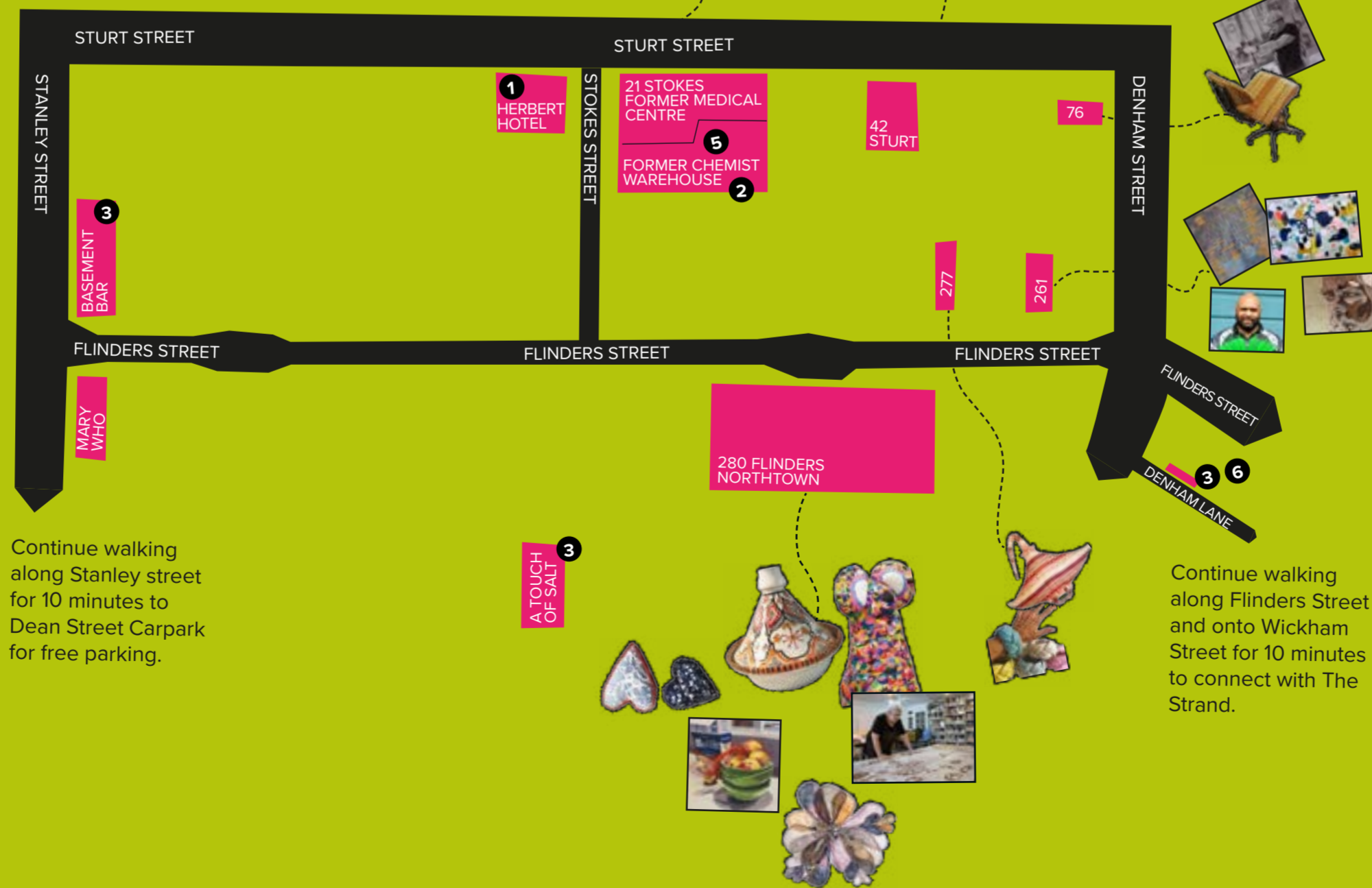
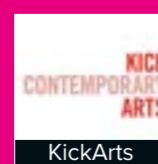
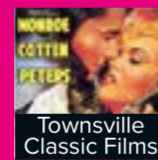

Hannah Murray



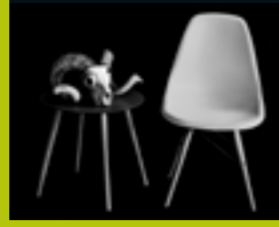
An artist and art teacher, Hannah works across a variety of different mediums, including printmaking, painting and illustration.

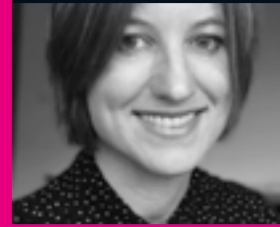
Athena Costopoulos

Arts Townsville is a collective of work by Lynn Scott-Cumming and Graeme Buckley, both visual artists and writers.

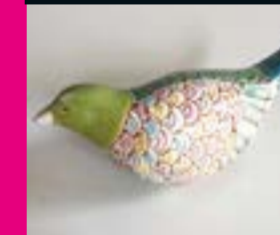
Deborah O'Toole
